Banzai Financial Literacy

It's more important than ever for young people to develop sound financial skills that prepare them for the real world. Since August 2015, Frontier Community Credit Union has sponsored a program for local schools called Banzai. It's an interactive, online program that aligns with Kansas curriculum requirements for personal finance education.

Students using the program are exposed to real-life scenarios where they learn to pay bills and balance a budget – but it's not always easy. Students must learn to manage unexpected expenses such as parking tickets, interest charges and overdraft fees. The educational program also introduces students to auto loans, financial statements, entertainment costs, savings and more.

Because we sponsor the program, educators who want to teach this in their classrooms can do so at no cost. We're proud to currently sponsor Banzai in 30 local schools, including in the Leavenworth, Lansing and Atchison school districts!
